

June Han Harp

A native of Korea, **June Han** holds a Premier Prix for Harp and Chamber Music from the Conservatoire National Supérieur de Musique de Paris in France and a master of music and artist diploma degree from the Yale School of Music. Prizewinner at the Soka International Competition in Japan and the Concerto Competition in Aspen, Han has appeared in numerous solo recitals and orchestral performances in Korea, France and throughout the United States. She has performed in Carnegie Hall, Brooklyn Academy of Music, Alice Tully Hall, Merkin Hall, the Cooper Union and Miller Theater with the Chamber Music Society of Lincoln Center, Sea Cliff Chamber Players, Speculum Musicae, Orpheus Chamber Orchestra as well as with Ensemble Sospeso, Sequitur Ensemble and Ensemble 21, of which she has been member since 1998. Han has also been working regularly with the Orchestra of Paris since 2000 and participated in their North American Tour in January 2002. A member of the Bowdoin Summer Music Festival faculty since 1996, Han has performed in summer festivals including Aspen and Tanglewood in the U.S.; in France, "Academies musicales" in Villecroze, Gargillette, Le Blanc and Nice.
