**Jeremy McCoy** (double bassist) has been a member of the Metropolitan Opera Orchestra since 1985. After attending the Cutis Institute of Music, he began his career with the National Arts Centre Orchestra in his native Ottawa, Canada. Apart from his orchestral duties, McCoy is active as soloist, chamber musician and commercial session player. He has attended several internationally recognized summer festivals including Marlboro, Banff and the Grand Tetons. McCoy has taught at the Affinis Music Festival in Japan and is currently on the faculty of the Bowdoin Summer Music Festival and adjunct professor of music at Columbia University. As a performer of new music, he appears regularly with Speculum Musicae, Ensemble and Sospeso. McCoy was winner of the 1991 Olga Koussevitzky Competition and has been the recipient of awards from the Canada Council.
